Wales Cancer Biobank has recently been supporting an exciting new study developed by researchers from the All Wales Medical Genomics Service (AWMGS) and leading oncologists in Wales.

Dr Magda Meissner and the team at AWMGS aim to shorten the time from referral to the start of treatment for lung cancer patients. Allowing doctors to select appropriate, personalised and timely treatments - without the need for patients to undergo risky and intrusive biopsies.
